CONCESSION STAND COMMITTEE (our primary fund raising activity)

- AIDING** Committee Chairperson in the task of **ordering and/or pick-up and delivery** of inventory/stock.
- SET-UP** of Concession Stand at games or events at H.G. Stadium, usually done the earlier part of the Friday of which the home game will take place usually accomplished between 2:00 P.M. and 5:00 P.M.
- WORKING THE CONCESSION STAND** at any games or events at H.G. Stadium usually accomplished between the hours of 5:30 P.M. and 9:30 P.M.
- FOOD SUPPLY** Provide food that we can sell in our stand as approved by the Committee Chairperson.
- IMPORTANT!!! CLEAN UP** of concession stand at any or all games or events at H.G. Stadium, usually accomplished between the hours of 9:30 P.M. and 10:30 P.M.

OTHER IMPORTANT COMMITTEES

- CHAPERONES** – Needed for BAND CAMP, Band Camp Mixer, Parades, Away Football Games (Bus and Equipment), Spring Trip, Competitions and other events.
- FUNDRAISING** (Ways and Means) – Help sort candles when they arrive, help chairperson as needed through the year.
- UNIFORM COMMITTEE** – Helping to fit and distribute to all Band and Color Guard members, and collecting the uniforms at the end of the school year. Fitting is usually done during Band Camp in August.
- PHONE CHAIN VOLUNTEER** - Contact parents/students who have no internet access (by telephone), whenever the need arises (changes in scheduling, etc.)

- BAND BANQUET COMMITTEE**- Helping to organize, presentation of, and finalization of the Annual Band Banquet (usually held in late November). Chaperones also needed.
- RELAY FOR LIFE ADULT CHAIRPERSON AND COMMITTEE**- Help organize and assist with fundraising, food supply, chaperone scheduling, tent set up, selling items, and other activities associated with relay.
- BUDGET COMMITTEE**- Meets to decide expenditures for the band and band front. Work with Treasurer to develop annual budget.
- ALUMNI COMMITTEE** – Help committee chair to communicate with HAHS Marching Cougars for participation in events throughout the year especially Alumni Night Football Game.
- PUBLICITY COMMITTEE**–Responsibilities include but are not limited to communication to local media about scheduled events, obtaining pictures of events to be sent in to newspapers and other publications.
- TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE** – This committee is responsible for the videotaping and photographing of concerts, football games, parades, and other events for compiling a DVD/CD of these events. (Must have own equipment).

Please note: Volunteering for any or all of these committees does not bind you to **all** of the activities the committee of your choice is responsible for. When necessary, meetings will be conducted to discuss the details for each event by the committee. Volunteers will be contacted as needed.
